

The School of Hospitality Business Scholarship Application Form

Applications are accepted and considered during Spring Semester for disbursement the following school year. Seniors can receive scholarships up through their graduation semester. To be considered, applications must be complete and submitted between February 1 - April 15.

Applicants for The School of Hospitality Business Scholarships must meet the following criteria and any criteria stipulated by the individual scholarship endowment for which they are being considered.

1. Applicants must be full-time students in The School of Hospitality Business when receiving a scholarship, unless they are receiving a scholarship during their last semester and full-time enrollment is not needed for graduation.
2. Applicants must submit a current resume. It is strongly recommended that applicants meet with SIRC staff during walk-in hours for assistance with their resume.
3. Junior and Senior applicants should have completed one of the required internships.
4. Applicants' active membership in The School of Hospitality Business student organizations or events is a consideration; however, applicants' stipulated need for paid work or a heavy course-load are alternative/complementary considerations.
5. Applicants must complete the attached fillable application in its entirety and submit electronically to shb.scholarships@broad.msu.edu.

Please note that scholarships are awarded based on the following:

'Citizen of the School Scholarship' (current academic year)

Levels of Citizenship-

Students who participate in:

- 1.) Hospitality Association (HA) student organizations and/or HA events and are official members*.
- 2.) Serve on the executive board of an HA student organization and/or HA event.
- 3.) Hold leadership positions (CEO/President) within HA are eligible to apply for a scholarship. Awards will be based on level of engagement and endowment-specified criteria.

**Official Members* are students who maintain a greater than 80% attendance at HA organization meetings, participate in at least 2 HA organization organized philanthropic events each AY, AND at least one HA organization event per semester.

The HA consists of: Business Golf Club, Club Managers Association of America (CMAA), Eta Sigma Delta, Global Hospitality Business Organization (GHBO), Hospitality and Lodging Club (HLC), National Society of Minorities in Hospitality (NSMH), Meeting and Events Club (MEC), Real Estate Investment Club (REIC), Society for Hospitality Foodservice Management (SHFM), Spartan Beverage Society and Destination Auction, Les Gourmets, and CAREER EXPO.

Academic Performance Scholarship (MSU CUM GPA, end of spring semester)

Students who achieve a greater than 3.0 GPA end of the current academic year (AY) are eligible to apply for scholarships. Awards will be based on level of GPA and endowment-specified criteria.

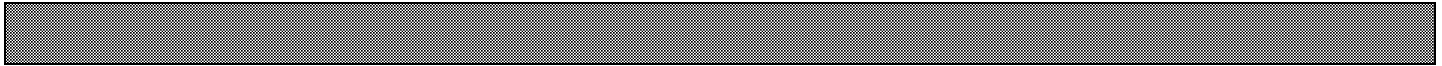

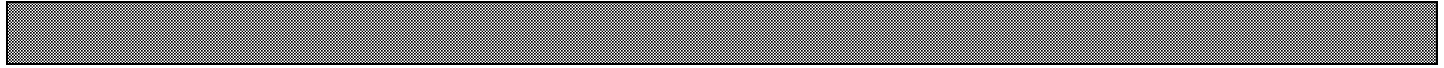

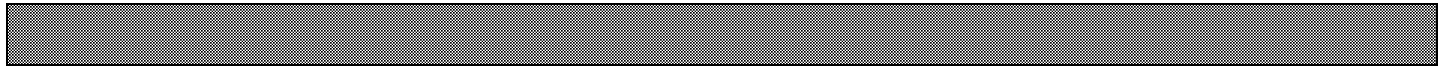
