### **Information to Consider Prior to Studying Abroad:**

- Students are not permitted to take more than 12 total combined credits from the Business Core and Major Field during their semester Education abroad experience.
- Students are not eligible to earn specific course credit if the prerequisite from MSU and host institution has not been satisfied.
- <u>Business</u> courses taken during Education abroad will return to MSU as transfer credits. For the credit to be transferred, a **minimum of a 2.0** must be earned in each course based on MSU transfer standards.
