



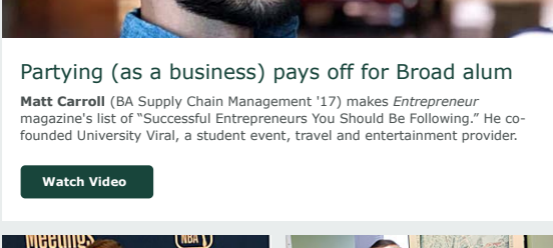
MBA students get a personal view of the Motor City, while doing their part to help and learn
