An end to yet another academic year is upon us. As we finish 2018-19 and look ahead, I'd like to take a moment to reflect on just some of what we have to celebrate.

First and foremost, we celebrate the fact that this spring **over 1,200 students received their undergraduate degrees** from the Broad College and over 400 students received advanced (graduate) degrees. Among the achievements earned by Broad Spartans, 16 of our undergraduate students were recognized with Board of Trustees Awards for graduating with a perfect 4.0 GPA.

Our alumni were also well represented at commencement. Linda Hubbard (BA Accounting '82), COO and president of Carhartt, was the **Broad Undergraduate Commencement Speaker**, and Natalya Leahy (MBA '06), John Duffey (BA Accounting '82), and Mike Krimbill (BA Accounting '76) were recognized with Broad College Alumni Achievement Awards.

- For the third straight year, Broad is home to the best undergraduate and graduate supply chain and logistics program in the nation, according to U.S. News & World Report.
 The Broad College completed the Empower Extraordinary capital campaign having raised \$195.9M, representing 143% of our campaign goal.
 The Edward J. Minskoff Pavilion received its formal title at a naming ceremony in honor of Minskoff (BA Economics '62) for his generous gift to the college, which was the largest single donation in the history of MSU. The Minskoff Pavilion will open its doors in time for this upcoming Fall 2019 semester.
- Other noteworthy happenings at Broad included the successful launch of our M.S. in Healthcare Management program as well as our first BroadX event in Houston, showcasing our faculty's scholarship, which we will look to expand on with future events in more locales—so stay tuned.
- This was truly a fantastic academic year for these and many other reasons, in large part due to the overwhelming generosity, guidance, and support provided by our proud alumni.
