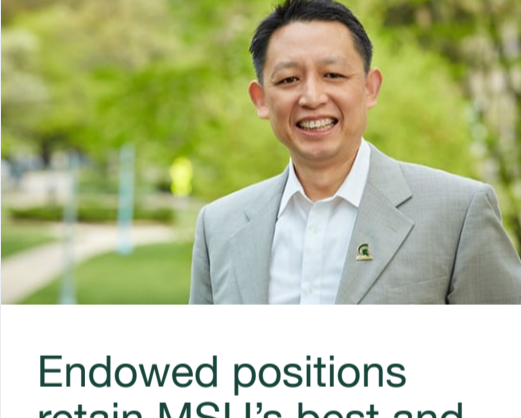

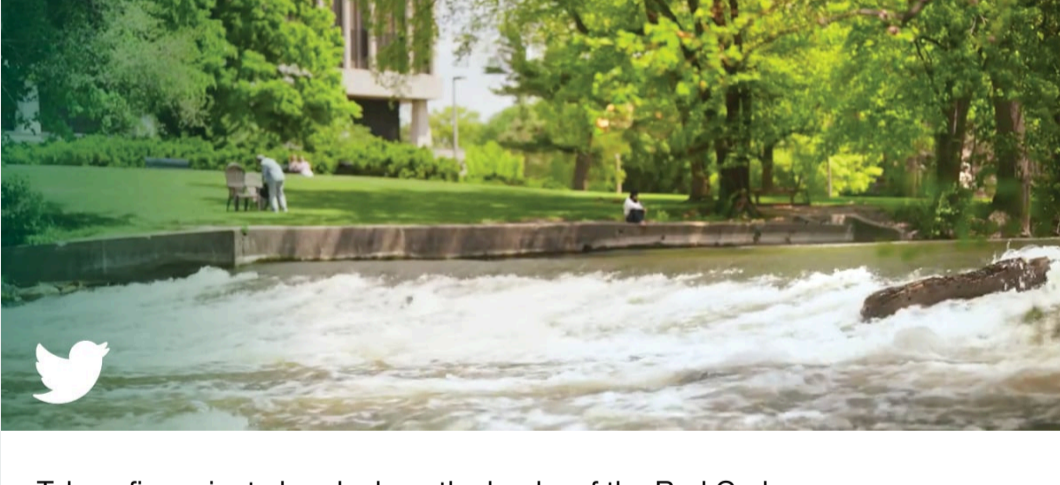


SHFM scholarship created to honor Tim Mehlberg
