

# Academic Semester Education Abroad Guidelines

**\*These guidelines do not apply to Faculty-Directed programs. \***

### Information to Consider Prior to Studying Abroad:

- Students are not permitted to take more than 12 total combined credits from the Business Core and Major Field during their semester Education abroad experience.
- Students are not eligible to earn specific course credit if the prerequisite from MSU and host institution has not been satisfied.
- **Business** courses taken during Education abroad will return to MSU as transfer credits. For the credit to be transferred, a **minimum of a 2.0** must be earned in each course based on MSU transfer standards.

- No more than 10 of the last 30 total (120) credits toward a degree may be transferred without approval by the Vice Provost for Undergraduate Education and Dean of Undergraduate Studies.

- ITM 209 – No equivalent international course
- MKT 250 – No equivalent international course
- FI 311 – **Finance** majors may NOT take this course abroad
- MKT 300 – **Marketing** majors may NOT take this course abroad
- MKT 317 – **Marketing** and **Supply Chain** majors may NOT take this course abroad
- SCM 303 – **Supply Chain Management** majors may not take this course abroad
- IBUS 310
- MGT 315 – No equivalent international course
- GBL 385 – No equivalent international course
- MGT 409 – No equivalent international course
