Although publications, citations, and the generation of future scholars are clear signs of research accomplishment, another critical role where our faculty shapes the scholarly landscape is through their gatekeeping function as Editors in Chief (EIC), Senior Associate Editors (SAE), Department Editors (DE) and Associate Editors (AE) of major journals. Faculty members who serve in such roles have a major influence on the knowledge base, both in terms of the decisions they make when it comes to what is accepted, but also the constructive feedback they provide for papers that are rejected – and perhaps improved as part of the scholarly review process. As part of the plan to expand the evidence of what constitutes research accomplishment, the current Strategic Plan for Research and Scholarship seeks to recognize individuals who have taken on such roles in journals that are strategically targeted by the college and the units. Because of disciplinary differences in titles, we place in parentheses the number of people who performed the role at the respective journal according to the journal's website.
