The current Strategic Plan for Research and Scholarship highlights a new set of journal lists for the Colleges and Units. At the pinnacle of this list is a set of journals that are strategically targeted by both the College and the Units. We refer to these as FT*, where the FT stands for the Financial Times 50 List (the college is annually ranked on this widely cited list and so it is a strategic priority for the college) and the * indicates that this journal is also a top priority for the Units. We would like to recognize the publications that “Hit the Spot” on the FT* list for the period between January 1, 2023 - December 31, 2023, according to the Web of Science. In terms of trends, the school had 19 FT*s this year, down from 32 last year.
