

## Guardians of the Gate 2023: ADR Series Part 5

Although publications, citations, and the generation of future scholars are clear signs of research accomplishment, another critical role where our faculty shape the scholarly landscape is through their gatekeeping function as Editors in Chief (EIC), Department Editors (DE), Senior Editors (SE) and Associate Editors (AE) of major journals. Faculty members who serve in such roles have a major influence on the knowledge base, both in terms of the decisions they make when it comes to what is accepted, but also the constructive feedback they provide for papers that are rejected – and perhaps improved as part of the scholarly review process. As part of the plan to expand the evidence of what constitutes research accomplishment, the current Strategic Plan for Research and Scholarship seeks to recognize individuals who have taken on such roles in journals that are strategically targeted by the college and the units.

Because many of our tenure stream faculty serve as reviewers on editorial boards (which of course are the gateways for EIC, DE, SE and AE roles) we do not list all editorial board service here. Instead, we focused on roles where the EIC, DE, SE or AE has **formal authority to make 25 or more accept/reject decisions a year**. We pulled this data from Faculty Activity Reports (FARs), and then submitted the list to our six AUH's to check for accuracy with respect to our criteria. With this as context, the list for 2023 includes:
