



Laptop Computer Requirements

Class of 2020

The Broad College requires all incoming Executive MBA students to own a laptop computer. Supported operating systems include Windows 7, Windows 8, Windows 8.1, and Windows 10. Support for Mac's will be provided on a limited basis; some classes may require software to be run on a PC. Microsoft Office is required on all computers. If you plan to use a computer provided by work you will need to have permission to install programs, add printers and change network settings.

If you do not have a computer that meets these minimum requirements the Broad College Information Technology Services (ITS) recommends the following configuration:

Dell Latitude 7480 - current approximate cost is \$1339. (<https://www.cstore.msu.edu/>). Anything close to or greater than this configuration will be adequate for the EMBA program.

- 8 GB RAM
- 500 GB Hard drive
- 10/100 Ethernet adapter with 802.11 G Wireless
- Windows 10
- 14" FHD Anti-Glare screen
- Up-to-date Anti-Virus Software (also available at MSU's Computer Store)
