## **POLICY**:

- 1. A senior from MSU who is in their final semester of graduation from first bachelor's degree and who is admitted into the Master of Science in Accounting Program may be dually enrolled.
- 2. You need to apply for graduation from your undergraduate degree. The form is online at <a href="https://www.reg.msu.edu/stuforms/gradapp/gradapp.aspx">https://www.reg.msu.edu/stuforms/gradapp/gradapp.aspx</a>.
- 3. You must schedule an appointment with your undergraduate academic advisor to ensure you meet the requirements to graduate.
- 4. The maximum time limit for dual enrollment is one semester.
- 5. A maximum of 9 graduate credits may be earned under this status.
- 6. The total maximum course load per term is 16 credits.
- 7. The extent to which the courses listed on this form will meet specific graduate degree requirements will depend on approval of your comprehensive graduate program.
- 8. If you wish to make any changes to the courses listed on this form, you must complete a second Dual Enrollment Status and indicate that it is REVISED.
- 9. Students request for dually enrolled are not eligible for graduate assistantships, or other forms of graduate student financial aid, or those services and prerogatives normally reserved for graduate students. We recommend that if you plan to apply for financial aid, you meet with a financial aid officer to discuss the impact of the additional cost to take these courses.
- 10. Credits taken at the graduate level do not count toward achievement of the bachelor's degree.
- 11. You will be charged additional program tuition fees per graduate credit in the middle of the semester you plan to dual enroll. Any credits you take at the graduate level will be charged at graduate tuition rates and will also be charged the additional program tuition fee per credit.
