- Step 2 Research Financial Aid and Scholarship Opportunities (http://educationabroad.isp.msu.edu/students/getting-started/financing/).
- Step 3 Apply to a program (<a href="http://educationabroad.isp.msu.edu/students/apply">http://educationabroad.isp.msu.edu/students/apply</a>).
- **Step 4** Meet with the program coordinator to discuss the internship placement and course enrollment process.
- **Step 5** Receive an admission decision and accept your seat on the program.
- **Step 6** Meet with a Broad College Study Abroad Coordinator to discuss the impact of internship credits on your degree plan and graduation requirements.
  - Broad majors (excluding Hospitality Business) are allowed a maximum of 3
    credits (two distinct 1 credit enrollments for accounting majors) of internship or
    other work experience to count toward the required electives for graduations.
