### Business Core:

- MKT 250 – No equivalent international course
- FI 311 – Finance majors may not take this course abroad
- GBL 385 – No equivalent international course
- ITM 209 – No equivalent international course
- MGT 315 – Human Resource Management and Management majors may not take this course abroad
- MGT 409 – This course may not be taken abroad
- MKT 300 – Marketing majors may not take this course abroad
- MKT 310
- MKT 317 – This course should not be taken abroad by **Marketing** and **Supply Chain** majors
- SCM 303 – Supply Chain Management majors may not take this course abroad

### Additional Information to Consider Prior to Studying Abroad:

- Students are not permitted to take more than 12 total combined credits from the Business Core and Major Field during their semester study abroad experience.
- Students are not eligible to earn specific course credit if the prerequisite from MSU and host institution has not been satisfied.
- **Business** courses taken during study abroad will return to MSU as transfer credits. In order for the credit to be transferred, a **minimum of a 2.0** must be earned in each course.
